**3. FLAG CEREMONY:** All vendors and guests at Honolulu Hale Civic Grounds will be asked to join the blessing and flag ceremony at the main flagpole at 12:00 noon to begin the day collectively. Please be prepared to secure your tent during this time.

- **4. TENT, TABLES, AND CHAIRS:** Exhibitor, cultural practitioner, or food vendor will provide own 10' x 10' tent, tables, and chairs. No spiking is allowed on the grounds. All tents must be located away from the central Hawaiian Flag and the main stage. Vendors must bring their own water barrels, sand bags or cynder blocks to anchor their tents.
- **5. PARKING PASSES:** Parking is limited so please arrive early. Sunday is free street parking.
- **6. DELIVERY OF SUPPLIES AND EQUIPMENT:** Driving or parking on the Honolulu Hale Civic Grounds is prohibited. Please plan accordingly in the delivery of supplies and equipment. Cars will be allowed to drive and unload along King Street. Vendors are prohibited from driving their vehicles on the grass/grounds.
